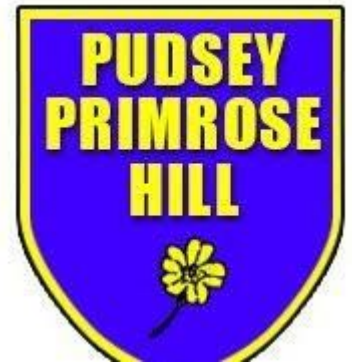




A Day in Reception



When children arrive into the classroom

- Show 5 on the carpet, listen to music and chat with friends before their teacher takes the register and we say good morning to each other.

Through school we use the term "show 5", this is for the expectation that children are ready to learn.

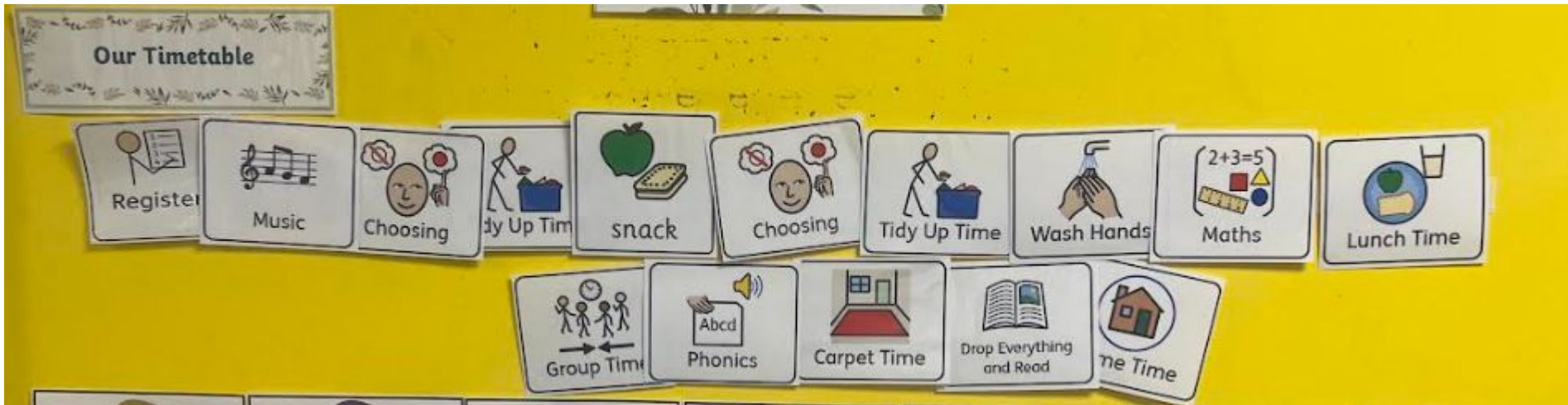
- Locked lips

Areas of provision in Reception



Toilets

Children can access the classroom toilet at all times throughout the day. We support children when needed, with accessing the toilet and reminders are made during the whole day to all children to go.



Snack Time

We have snack time at 10:15am, children are all given a piece of fruit. It is optional for children to bring in their own fruit at snack time.

Children also have the option to have milk during snack time. This is free until your child turns 5.

Office staff will contact you about ordering milk for your child.



Tapestry

Tapestry is an online learning journal used to track and document your child's development in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). We record observations, photos, and videos of your child's learning, making it easier to assess progress and share updates with everyone at home. The platform promotes strong home-school communication and supports individualised learning, helping us align your child's development with the early learning goals.
