


# Knowledge Organiser Significant people in history Florence Nightingale



# **Key Facts**

- Florence Nightingale was born in Florence, Italy on 12th May 1820
- Florence Nightingale worked as a nurse during the Crimean War and helped improve the conditions of hospitals.
- Hospitals during the Crimean War were very dirty and unhygienic.
- Florence Nightingale met Queen Victoria and was awarded the Royal Red Cross.
- Florence Nightingale died in 1910.
- Edith Cavelle also helped wounded soldiers but from both sides.
- Florence, Edith and Mary were all battlefield nurses who helped soldiers.
