**LKS2** - Someone from school has sent you a nasty message online. What should you do?

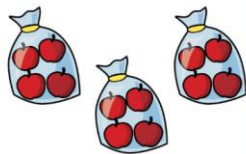
**UKS2** - A classmate sends a picture to your phone which makes you feel uncomfortable. What should you do?
