LKS2 - Your parents tell you that you cannot join something online because it's not suitable for someone your age. Your friend tells you 'Just do it in secret'. What should you do?

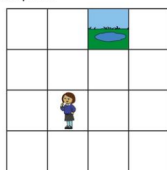
UKS2 - You are thinking about signing up to a new cool site where you can post pictures and talk to others who have joined. To join, it asks for personal information. What should you do?
