Year 5 Local History

This week, Year 5 took part in our local history walk. We visited St Andrews Church in Pudsey, where we were lucky enough to learn about the age of the Church as well as the building itself. Everyone enjoyed observing the different buildings on the route to the Church and linking that to the research we had done in class.



Year 4 Local History

As part of their Local History Walk the children in Year 4 went to the Moravian Settlement of Fulneck. Here, the children did a meditation walk where they saw lots of fantastic buildings, some that were built when the settlement was established in 1744. They asked lots of interesting questions and then sketched a part of the settlement that interested them.



Year 6 Local History

For our Local History study we have researched Booths Yard. Originally called Hammerton Fold it got its current name from the Booth family who used to own the grocers shop there until 1983. We used Digimaps to look at maps over time to see the differences in the area.

Fun facts about Costa Rica:

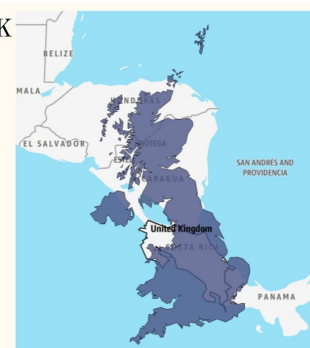
- Costa Rica has no army, it was abolished in 1949.
