




## Protecting Our Planet Day

As part of our new Climate Change curriculum we had a whole school Super Learning Day to support our climate change scientific knowledge. Classes discussed climate change topics and produced labels, explanations and persuasive posters.

Y1 discussed ways that we can protect our planet e.g. picking up litter, asking to walk to the shop instead of driving. We looked at a book called ' Weather: My First Experiments' and talked about the difference between weather and climate. We then worked in groups of 2 to read statements and decide whether it was describing the weather or climate.



Y6 spent an engaging day learning how to Protect Our Planet! They got to grips with scientific terms like the atmosphere, climate change, and greenhouse gas emissions. Through fun and informative videos, the children learned about the Earth's natural ways of cleaning the air, focusing on how growing trees, healthy soil, and oceans help remove greenhouse gases. The day ended with them putting their persuasive skills to the test by creating eye-catching posters to share their vital message!


