Year 5 and Year 6 enrichment opportunities

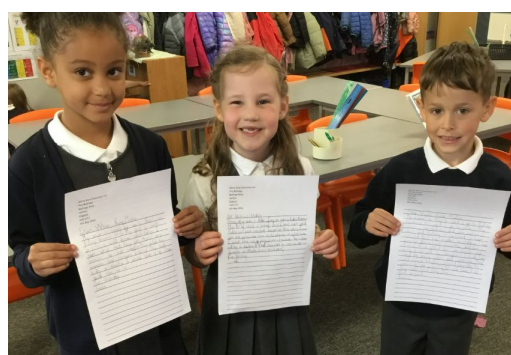

As part of enrichment sessions Y5 have taken part in food technology. They have learnt safe and effective knife skills, where food used has come from and this half term they have made nachos, spring rolls, cous cous and tikka turnovers.



As part of Y6 DT enrichment sessions pupils develop measuring skills, sawing, nailing and screwing in hinges to make their own memory boxes.

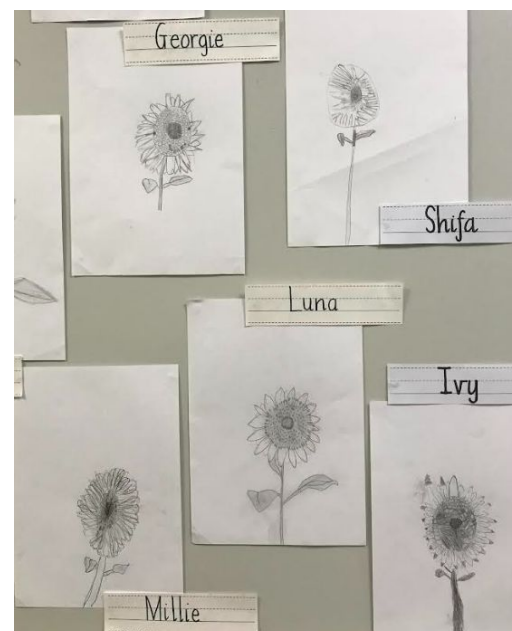
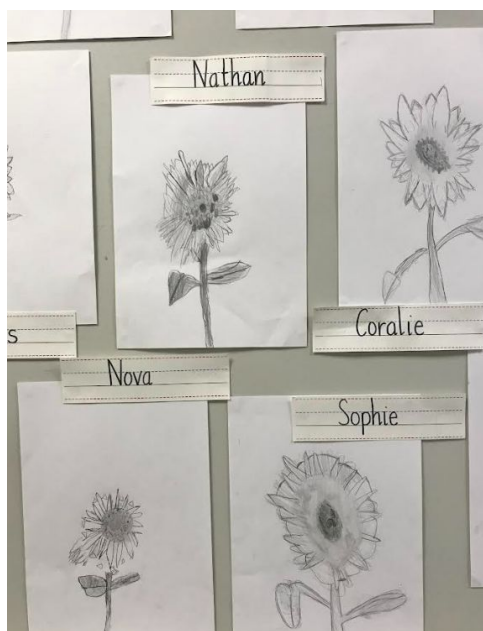
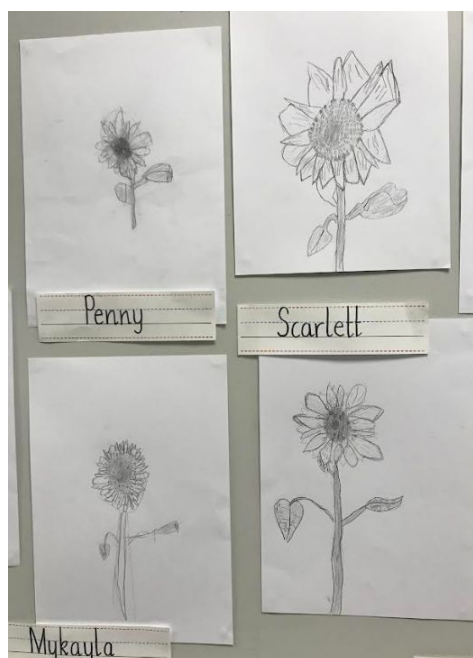
Year 2 Baking

We will have extra props for you to carry and join in the fun. All children must be accompanied by an adult who is responsible for them throughout the event.

This event is one of the Year 4 Owlcotes Elements 'Community Spirit' and they have been working hard to prepare for the day.

This year the theme is 100 Years of David Attenborough and we have chosen to focus on 'Blue Planet' and saving our seas! The props that have been created are all made from recycled resources. All we ask is that children (and parents) dress in blue or in 'underwater' costumes (fish, whales, octopus etc!) Lower KS2 children have been learning the song 'Under the Sea' and will be singing and dancing to this throughout the parade.
