Nursery Visit Kirkstall Abbey

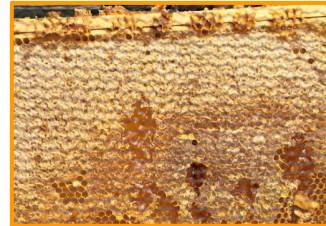
This week children in nursery have travelled in the school minibuses for an adventure in the grounds of Kirkstall Abbey.

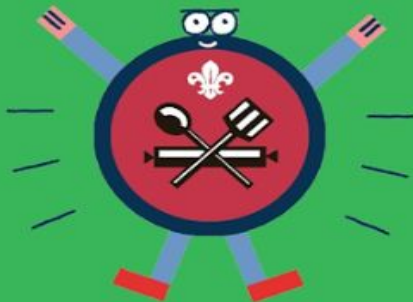
