

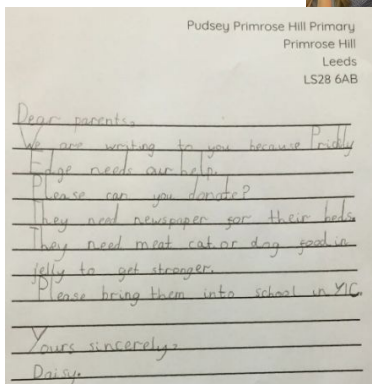
# Pudsey Primrose Hill

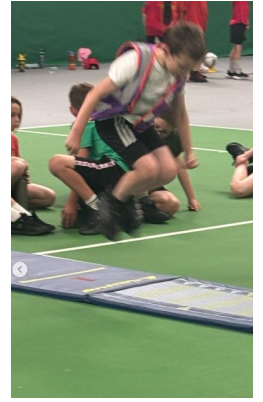
## Raising Aspiration cont...

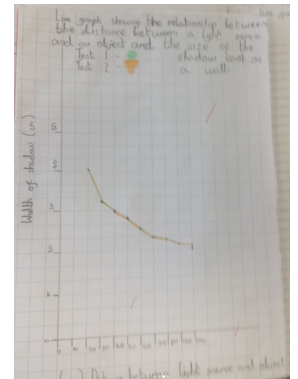
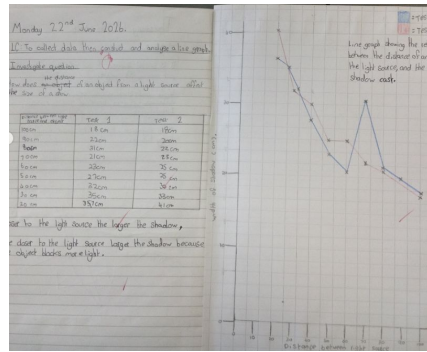
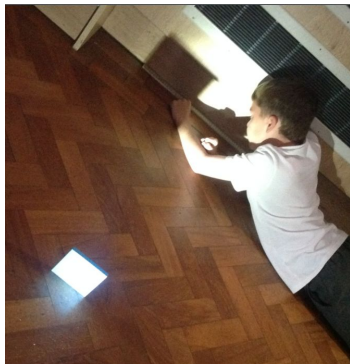
## Pudsey Olympics

## Year 6 Science

Scientists of the future! Today, Y6 children revisited some physics learning about light. They completed an investigation to see how the size of a shadow changed when a light source was moved closer or further away from the object. The children's data was presented in line graphs with children plotting both sets of results. This made sure they were completing a fair test.

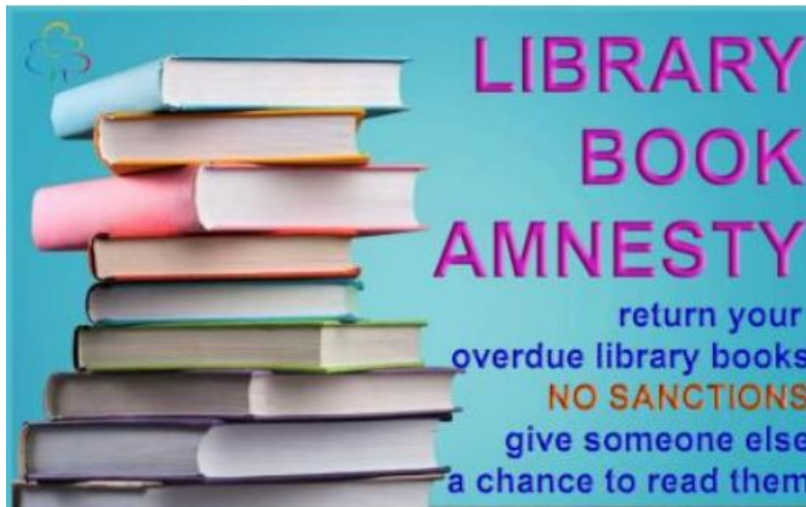
