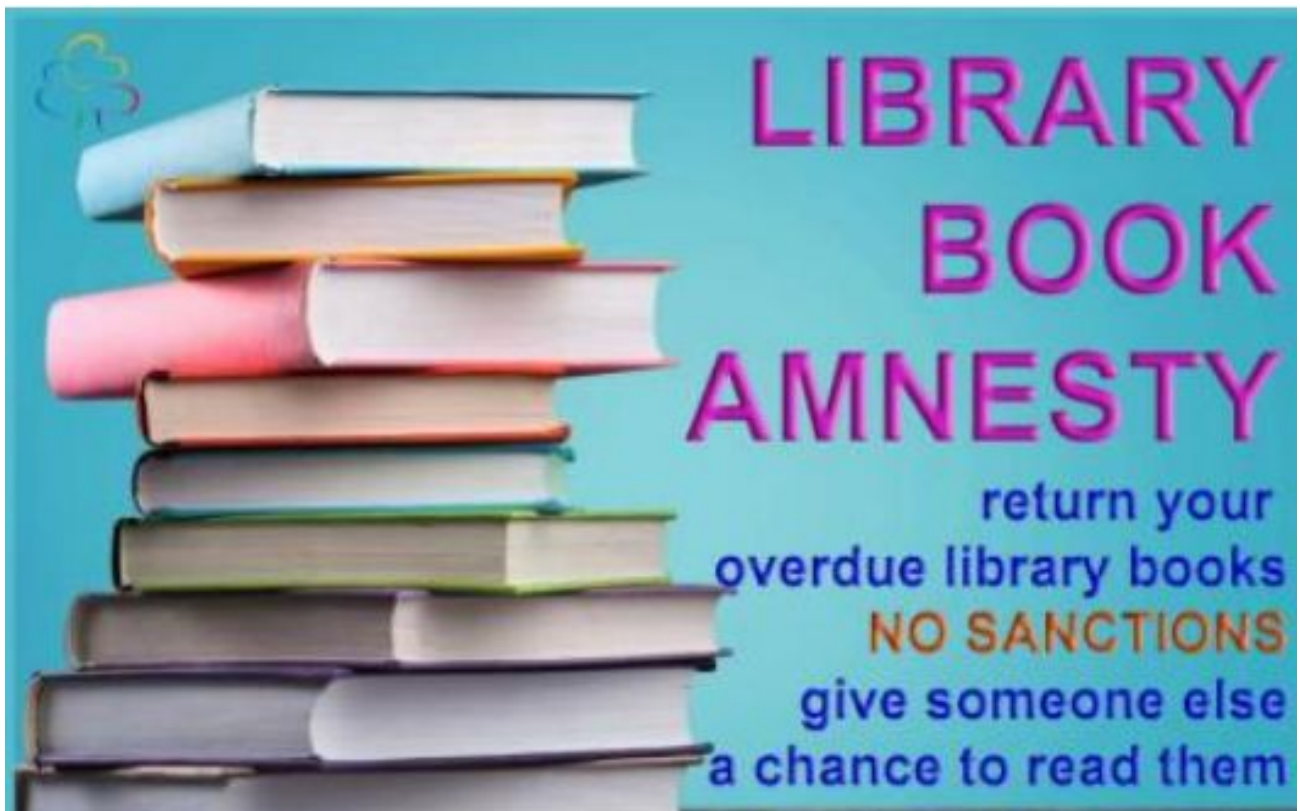
How can we get ready for the next stage in our education? What do we need to do to get ready?

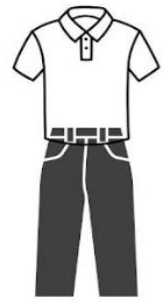
